The Informal Cities Workshop is an intensive hands-on workshop where students will grapple with the complexities and challenges of designing within an informal context. Working in the context of the Favelas in Rio reveals the friction and interconnections that exists between the informal and the formal aspects of the city. The workshop will be led by **Jorge Mario Jauregui**, a prominent Urbanist, founder of @telier metropolitan, and architect behind some of the most prominent design-led projects in the Rio Favelas. Jauregui's work includes the Favela-Barrio Project, a "slum to neighborhood" upgrading process funded by the Inter-American Development Bank.
